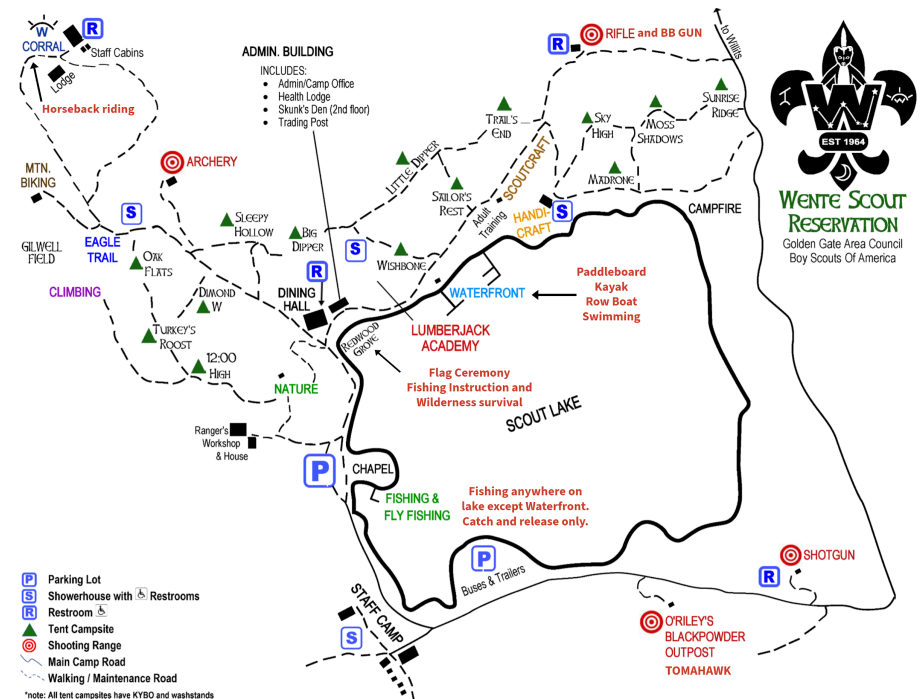

Activity Description

Archery	Map Location: Archery Shooting Range. Age Limit: For Ages 5 and up. Max Capacity 32 on range. Archers must complete a 15 minute safety orientation prior to shooting.
Rifle*	Map Location: Rifle Range. Age Limit: 11 and up. Cost: \$2.5/target, 5 rounds. Buy Tickets at the Trading Post or at the activity site. Max Capacity: 32 including BB Gun. Shooters must complete a 15 minute safety orientation prior to shooting.
BB Gun	Map Location: Rifle Range. Age Limit: 5 and up. Max Capacity: 32 including Rifle. Shooters must complete a 15 minute safety orientation prior to shooting.
Shotgun*	Map Location: Shot Gun Range. Plan for a 10-15 minute walk. Age Limit: 13 and up. Cost: \$2/Clay, 1 round. Buy Tickets at the Trading Post or at the activity site. Max Capacity: 12. Shooters must complete a 15 minute safety orientation prior to shooting.
Rowboat	Map Location: Waterfront. Age Limit: None. Max Capacity: 5 boats, 3 people per boat. Lifejackets available for 5 and up. Please BYO Lifejackets for 5 and under children. Parents must accompany children.
Kayak	Map Location: Waterfront. Age Limit: None, must know how to swim. Max Capacity: 15 single rider kayaks. Lifejackets available for 5 and up.
Paddle board	Map Location: Waterfront. Age Limit: None, must know how to swim. Max Capacity: 7 single person paddle boards. Lifejackets available for 5 and up.
Swimming	Map Location: Waterfront. Age Limit: None. Max Capacity: 10:1 lifeguard ratio. Swim only when lifeguards are on duty. Lifejackets available for 5 and up. Please BYO Lifejackets for 5 and under children. Parents must accompany children.
Fishing	Map Location: Anywhere on the shore of the lake but the Waterfront. No fishing off the boats. BYO Fishing poles, bait and tackle. No license necessary. Try your luck with the lakes Largemouth Bass and BlueGill. Catch and Release only. Fly fish or use Floaters.
Kite Flying	Map Location: Over the lake or Gilwell Fields. BYO Kites
Hiking	Map Location: Follow the marked trails. Stay on the trails. Go with a buddy.
Arts and Crafts	Map Location: Pavilion next to Dining Hall. Come join us for scheduled arts and crafts activities!
Campfire/Skits	Map Location: Campfire. Saturday 8:15-10:00 pm

*Requires additional cost. Tickets may be purchased at Trading Post for horseback riding. Shooting sports may be purchased at Trading Post as well as at their respective activity sites.
